**Ages 6-8** 9:30-12:30

Campers will go on a magical journey of curious amphibious creatures, inspired by David Wiesner's picture book "Tuesday." In this introduction to the art of live performance, students create and perform a short musical play. Through improvisation, music and creative dramatics, students are inspired to write their own lines, design and make costumes, and build a simple set. All campers participate in the play, which will be performed for parents on Friday.

**Backstage Playhouse** May 23-27  
**Ages 9-12** 1:30-4:00

In this workshop, students will develop the basic skills every actor needs, including body and stage movement, pantomime, character development, scenes, monologues, improvisation and cooperation with other actors. Students are encouraged to learn all aspects of production. Emphasis on strong communication skills will help prepare students for many types of public speaking.

**Wee Arts Camp** June 20-24  
**Ages 4-5** 9:30-11:30

**Traveling with a Line**  
Children will explore the element of line in art, with a connection to travel. They will experiment with different types of line using collage, crayon resist, crayon etching, dot painting, texture rubbing, string painting and painting. Students will be introduced to related children's literature. Songs of transportation and direction will be used in creative movement. Camp T-shirt included.

**Ages 6-8** 9:30-12:30

**Leapin' Lizards**  
Campers will explore the creative process in three classes each day. They will consider such questions as: where do artists get ideas, what is art, and what is style, while working with a variety of materials. Students will delve into the lizard world by exploring their movements and song. Projects in the two visual art classes include collage, 3D accordion creatures, hand puppets, plus costumes and instruments to use in the Friday performance. They will also design their own camp T-shirts.

**Metamorphoses**  
[metamorphosis: to undergo a marked change in form, texture and physical appearance]  
Students experience three different visual arts classes each day. In printmaking class, they will learn the techniques of monoprinting (combination painting & printing) and collagraphy (combination collage & printing). In sculpture class they will transform household objects into creatures of their own design. And in drawing class, students will learn techniques of perspective and 3D drawing, and create tessellations like those done by MC Escher. Camp T-shirt, snacks, and one pizza lunch included.
